The Ambassador Project Camp is a one day camp focusing on multiple 4-H project areas ranging from large animals to robotics. Participants will receive instruction from expert leaders and accomplished senior 4-H members on all things related to preparing that project for fair. If you have questions about feeding, show prep, showmanship, or just how 4-H and fair works this camp is for your family! This camp will also be a great place for experienced 4-H members to hone their skills or try new projects. Please see the workshop descriptions on the second page for more detail on the specific classes offered. Lunch and dinner will be provided. Both 4-H members and parents are encouraged to attend!

A Project Skill-a-thon will also be included at the end of the camp (6-7pm). This skill-a-thon will test your knowledge across all things 4-H. The Skill-a-thon is not required but it will be lot of fun so campers are encouraged to get a team together. Be ready for questions on everything from pigs to cake decorating. Gather a team of four 4-H members and compete for the **Grand Prize... A free pass for the 2016 fair kitchen.** That's right, win this skill-a-thon and your team doesn't have to work a kitchen shift this year at fair!

Skill-a-thon rules: 1. A team must consist of four 4-H members and include one senior member, one junior member and one novice member. 2. Each team member must register before May 27<sup>th</sup>. 3. During the contest, teams must work together to answer the questions and complete all tasks.

## Workshop Descriptions:

**Swine – 1 hr.** This workshop will include instruction from expert leaders and accomplished 4-H members on all you need to know about the 4-H Market Swine project. The workshop will include hands-on learning and tips from the pros on feeding/nutrition, show fitting, and showmanship.

**Beef - 1 hr.** This workshop will include instruction from expert leaders and accomplished 4-H members on all you need to know about the 4-H Market Beef and Breeding Beef projects. The workshop will include hands-on learning and tips from the pros on feeding/nutrition, show fitting and clipping, and showmanship.

**Sheep/Goat - 1 hr.** This workshop will include instruction from expert leaders and accomplished 4-H members on all you need to know about the 4-H Market Sheep, Market Goat, Breeding Sheep, and Breeding Goat projects. The workshop will include hands-on learning and tips from the pros on feeding/nutrition, show prep, and showmanship.

**Rabbits – 30 min.** This workshop will include instruction from expert leaders and accomplished 4-H members on all you need to know about the 4-H Rabbit project. The workshop will include hands-on learning and tips from the pros on feeding/nutrition, show prep, and showmanship.

**Poultry – 30 min.** This workshop will include instruction from expert leaders and accomplished 4-H members on all you need to know about the 4-H Poultry project. The workshop will include hands-on learning and tips from the pros on feeding/nutrition, show prep, and showmanship.

**Cake Decorating – 1 hr.** Learn new cake decorating techniques and practice your skills before fair under the guidance of leaders and past fair winners.

**Leather – 2 hrs.** Practice your leather working skills of stamping, cutting, and more. During this workshop, each participant will make a personalized leather project to take home.

**Photography & Wood Art – 1 hr.** During this workshop, learn more about photography and the skills needed to take a show winning picture. In the craft section, participants will create a piece of artwork featuring the state of Montana using wood burners and barn wood.

**Cooking – 1 hr.** Learn the tips and tricks that will serve you well at the fair while cooking delicious food in this workshop. Practice cooking and preservation techniques with the experts!

**Robotics – 1.5 hrs.** Build and program a robot during this fun, interactive workshop. Taught by Melody Harris of Yellowstone County using LEGO robotic kits. Don't miss this unique robotics learning opportunity!



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
