

## 4-H GOALS

### Non-Project 4-H Goals (on your green 'My 4-H Year' sheet)



- What you want to do and learn in 4-H this year.
- Each year your goals should change and become more challenging.
- Goals may include leadership, communications, citizenship and/or community service.

#### **Example # 1**

Beginner member = I want to learn about 4-H and how I can be more involved by reading my 4-H newsletters and asking questions.

Junior member = I want to expand my knowledge of 4-H and the opportunities it provides by attending MT 4-H Rec Lab and the OREO Trip.

Senior member = I want to encourage 4-H members to attend MT 4-H Congress by speaking to 4-H Members and Leaders at County Events, meetings and writing articles.

#### **Example # 2**

Beginner member = I want to take part when my 4-H Club picks up litter for the adopt a highway program.

Junior member = I plan to clean up the fairgrounds before and after the fair; and the softball complex before and after softball season. I will invite my 4-H Club members to join me.

Senior member = I want to speak to younger members in our county's 4-H Clubs to help them plan and carry out various community service projects.

OR - I want to plan and educate 4-H members on how to safely pick up litter. I will ask the assistance of our County Emergency Medical Team.



### Project 4-H Goals (on your purple or blue 'My Project' sheet)



- What you want to do and learn in your 4-H Project this year.
- Why did you enroll in this project?
- Each year your goals should change and become more challenging.

#### **Example # 1**

Beginner member = I want to learn how to keep my market lamb healthy.

Junior member = I want to learn how to give shots to my 4-H lamb on my own.

Senior member = I want to plan and lead activities to help younger members learn about the health requirements of their lambs.

#### **Example # 2**

Beginning member = I want to learn the different types of wood used in building furniture.

Junior member = I want to build a piece of furniture using safe woodworking tool practices and choose the best wood for this project.

Senior member = I would like to build outdoor furniture for our nursing home. I will ask local carpenters for help and suggestions.
