# SOUTHEASTERN MONTANA 4-H CAMP RULES

1. NO alcohol or drugs at camp site.
2. NO youth under 4-H age will be allowed at the camp.
3. Girls are not allowed in the boys cabin, boys are not allowed in the girls cabin.
4. Counselors are expected to assist with activities, participate in the operation of the camp and supervise the members from their county.
5. Do not disturb others' personal property.
6. If severe homesickness prevails, parents will be contacted with the camper being sent home.
7. If rules are broken, member will be sent home at their own expense.
