September 10, 2017--Day Two of the State 4-H Working Ranch Horse Finals

Day 2 of Montana State 4-H Working Ranch Horse Finals will offer expanded versatility competition with four areas of competition in two arenas. There will be four divisions in each class---**Junior** (youth 4-H age 8-10), **Intermediate** (youth 4-H age 11-13), **Senior** (youth 4-H age 14+), and **Colt** (Horse age 5 and under--must be a 4-H Green Horse/Colt to Maturity Project). This day's events are open to any 4-H youth (not required to be enrolled in working ranch horse project). You may enter any 1 class or combination of classes.

- Working Cow Horse
- Reining
