Share information about you as a person. Emphasize your personal growth and development. This is your opportunity to share how 4-H has contributed to who you are! You could include your most significant 4-H projects, activities and experiences. If you identify projects and activities, discuss the skills you learned and how these experiences are important to you now and in the future. Share what you **learned** from these experiences and how they will assist you in the future.

Section 5: Career Goals

What is your major field of study? What are your reasons for choosing this course of study? How will your post-secondary education assist you in attaining your career goals?

Submit an official copy of your high school or college transcript. Home school youth must submit an ACT or SAT scores.
