

# 4-H Presentation Planning

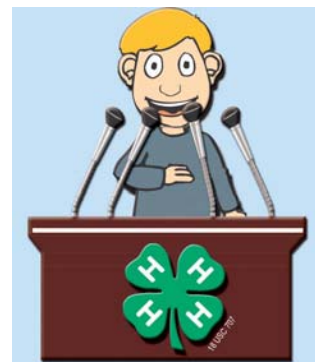
