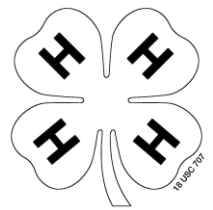

• Ready to Wear: Can be selected as 1 of 3 items for Fashion Revue. Requires Comparison Sheet for each article purchased for the Fashion Revue as well as commentary due at time of registration.

• Write a commentary about each entry. (A "commentary" is an informative description of you and what you made, for each item. You will use active, descriptive, original words. It should last 30-45 seconds from the announcer; during which time you will be showing off on the runway what you have made to the judges. Ex. If you made a pillow case you would dress in bed clothes with the pillow and show off the pillow.) **Commentary and paperwork turned in by Friday, April 14.**
