

**Wheatland County Youth Fair
Livestock Policies**

_____ All youth who participate in the Wheatland County Youth Fair must abide by all of the general rules and livestock rules in the WCYF book.

_____ All market animals must meet the Food and Drug Administration regulations governing management and safety practices. Only those growth stimulants and health aides approved and labeled for use on animals can be administered, and proper dosages and withdrawal times must be observed.

_____ No tranquilizers in any form may be administered to any animal at the fair.

_____ If an animal becomes ill or injured and is in need of treatment, exhibitor should seek appropriate veterinary care and treat the animal. If the treatment requires the usage of a drug and the animal will not meet the appropriate withdrawal time for that drug prior to the livestock sale, the exhibitor must report the situation to the livestock chairperson. If it is well and not contagious to other animals, the animal will be allowed to participate in the livestock show and sale, and the need for additional withdrawal time will be announced prior to the sale of the animal. The exhibitor will take the animal home and deliver it to the place of slaughter of the buyers choice (within 100 miles) after the proper withdrawal time has been met.

_____ Beef must weigh over 950 pounds to be included in the market class and sold in the livestock auction. Beef under 950 pounds will be shown in a feeder class. Beef weighing over 1450 pounds will be sold at 1450 pounds.

_____ Market swine must weigh at least 210 pounds to be shown in the market class and sold in the livestock auction. Market swine weighing less than 210 pounds will be shown in a feeder class. Market swine weighing over 340 pounds will be sold at 340 pounds.

_____ Market lambs must weigh at least 90 pounds to be shown in the market class and sold in the livestock auction. Market lambs weighing less than 90 pounds will be shown in a feeder class. Market lambs that weigh more than 175 pounds will be sold at 175 pounds.

_____ No feeder animals will be sold during the livestock auction.
